

Evangelistic Outreach Guidelines

Thank you for expressing interest in joining us for one of our upcoming outreaches. Please take note of the following basic requirements and guidelines for participating in evangelistic activity with Repent America:

I. Prerequisites/Requirements

- You must be born again. (John 3:7)
- You must believe that the Bible is the inspired, infallible, authoritative, and inerrant Word of God. (II Timothy 3:15-17; II Peter 1:21)
- You must believe that Jesus is the Son of God, born of a virgin, who lived a sinless life in obedience to the Law of God. He took our iniquity upon Himself on the cross as means of salvation and justification for fallen man. On the third day, He rose from the dead. (Galatians 4:4-5; I Peter 2:24; Romans 10:9)
- You must believe that Jesus is the ONLY way to God. (John 14:6)
- You must believe that repentance and faith in the Gospel are necessary for salvation. (Mark 1:15)
- You must believe in a literal heaven and hell. (Matt. 7:21; Matt. 10:28)
- You must not be involved in the usage of drugs or alcohol. (Prov. 20:1)
- You must not be involved in adultery, fornication, homosexuality, or any form of sexual deviancy. (I Corinthians 6:9-10)

II. Preparations

- Please pray about the evangelistic activities in the weeks leading up to the outreach. Pray for both the team and those hearing the message.
- Prepare your heart for the outreach. Come with a burden for the lost and a receptive ear to listen to the comments of others. (Jude 22-23)
- Come with team spirit. Remember, we are members of the Body of Christ, and are working together for a common goal. (I Corinthians 12:12-27; Ephesians 4:3)
- Be sure to bring ample funds to cover meals, travel, and lodging.
- Expect to be on your feet for long periods of time. Choose appropriate footwear.
- Please dress modestly. Ladies shirts or blouses must not be low-cut, neither revealing the mid-section. Skirts or dresses must be appropriate in length, and slacks or jeans must not draw attention to the body. Men's jeans must be well fitting.

III. Guidelines for Outreach Activity

- Please do not present any form of distraction to the Gospel message that is being presented.
- Expect the fact that there may be those who will be hostile toward the Gospel. When this occurs, remain calm, and if response is needed, do so in a respectful tone. (I Peter 2:23; Proverbs 15:1)
- If you have no former evangelism experience, you will be paired with a seasoned witness who will help to be your guide. Remember, God has not given us the spirit of fear, but of power, love, and a sound mind!
